Quarterly Statement of Production, Development and Exploration

SEPTEMBER 2010

Premier

Production

Overburden removal was 2.5 per cent lower than the previous quarter. Coal production for the quarter was 699,000 tonnes, 12.9 per cent higher than for the previous quarter due to becoming sole supplier to Verve Energy from 1 July 2010.

Development

There was no significant development activity during the quarter.

Exploration

There was no significant exploration activity during the quarter.

Curragh

Production

Overburden removal was 2.8 per cent higher than the previous quarter.

Coal production for the quarter was 2,082,000 tonnes (comprising 1,384,000 tonnes of metallurgical coal and 698,000 tonnes of steaming coal), 9.4 per cent lower than the previous quarter. Metallurgical coal production decreased by 14.1 per cent compared to the previous quarter, as a result of unseasonal wet weather impacting coal mining out of pits. Steaming coal production was 1.7 per cent higher than the previous quarter due mainly to higher contracted demand.

Development

As previously announced, the expansion of Curragh Mine up to 8.5 million tonnes per annum of export metallurgical coal was approved by the Wesfarmers Limited Board on 10 November 2009. Expansion works are underway, with the project scheduled for completion in late calendar year 2011.

Exploration

A drilling program was completed during the period at Curragh and Curragh North comprising 182 chip holes. The program was designed to target infill structural definition.

Bengalla

Production

Wesfarmers' share of coal production for the quarter was 445,000 tonnes, 24.7 per cent lower than the previous quarter due to operating in a less productive part of the mine sequence and wet weather.

Development

Feasibility studies to determine the viability of increasing ROM coal production from 8.7 to 10.7 million tonnes per annum are continuing.

Exploration

There was no significant exploration activity during the quarter.
